Margarita Bareikytė (1988, Lithuania) - theater/film director, actress. After studying directing, she worked as a theater director and actress in Lithuania. In 2018 she moved to Italy to pursue her career as a film director. In Italy, she creates a series of film projects, including two fiction short films, a

documentary, music videos, participates in film residencies and writes screenplays. Her works have been

awarded at several festivals, including the award at the Pigneto Film Festival (September 2020) for the best

short film "Tran Tran", which was subsequently screened during the Rome Film Festival; she had a special

mention at the Amarcort Film Festival (2023 November) for the documentary "On the Other Side".
